

Instructions for Referees

Recording Overtime and Penalty Kick Shoot-outs on Game Sheets and Online Game Reports

Overtime

For games that are decided in overtime, indicate “Overtime” in the Comments section of the game sheet and the online game report.

Penalty Kick Shoot-out

For games that are decided by penalty kicks, report only the goal scorers from regular time on the main part of the game sheet and online game report. One additional “team goal” is reported for the winning team in the final score, and the results of the penalty kick shoot-out are reported in the Comments.

The following example shows how to report a game that was tied 2-2 after regular time and a scoreless overtime, where the Red team beat the White team 4-2 in the penalty kick shoot-out.

a) Game Sheet

- Record the final score as 3-2 for Red.
- On the main part of the game sheet, record next to each player’s name who scored the two goals for Red and the two goals for White in regular time. Do not record any of the goal scorers of the penalty kicks in this section.
- In the Comments section, print “Red won shoot-out 4-2.”
- On the back of the game sheet, list the numbers of the players who took the penalty kicks for each team in the order in which they shot. Indicate with a check mark if they scored and an X if they missed.

e.g.:

<u>Red</u>		<u>White</u>	
8	√	11	X

b) Online Game Report

- Record the final score as 3-2 for Red.
- On the main part of the game report, record next to each player’s name who scored the two goals for Red and the two goals for White in regular time. Record a third goal for Red next to one of the spare numbers (e.g., #99). Do not record any of the goal scorers of the penalty kicks in this section.
- In the Comments section, type “Red won shoot-out 4-2.”
- Also in the Comments section, list the numbers of the players who took the penalty kicks for each team in the order in which they shot, indicating “goal” or “miss” after each number.
e.g.: “Penalty kicks: Red: 8 (goal), 3 (goal), 10 (miss), 5 (goal), 7 (goal). White: 11 (miss), 5 (goal), 2 (miss), 8 (goal).”
